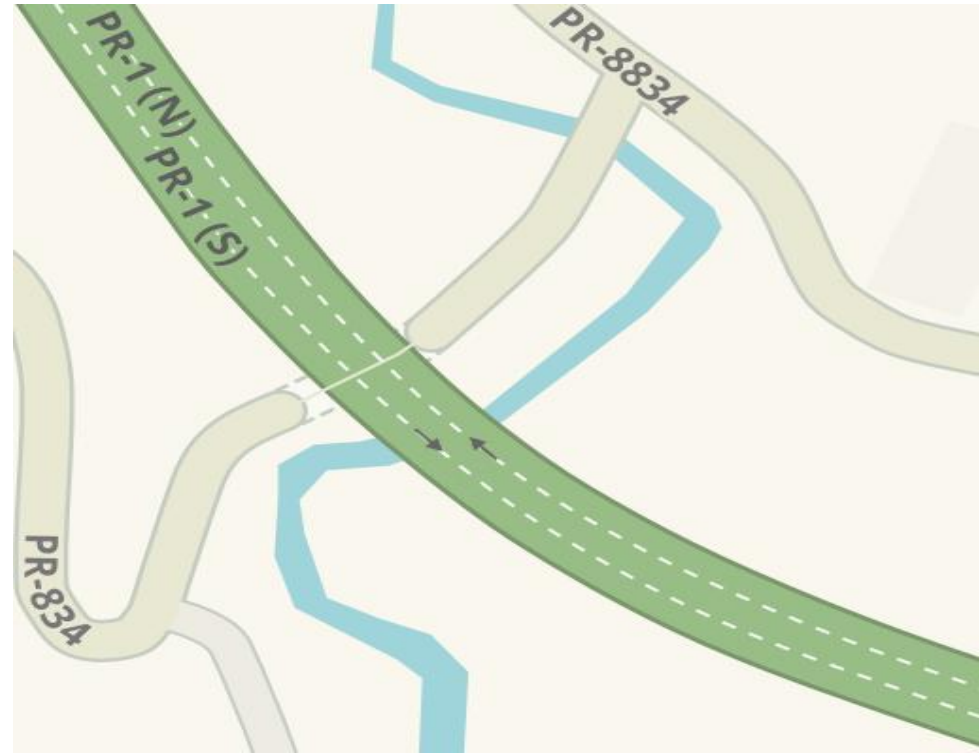

From the Pastor Meditation during the week!

"Jesus: The Way, the Truth, and the Life"

Text: John 14:6

***Jesus is the Way** - Read: **John 14:6; Acts 4:12; Isaiah 35:8**

Discussion Questions:

- What does it mean to you that Jesus doesn't just show the way, but **He is the Way**?
- What "other ways" does the world try to offer us today?
- How can we help others find and follow this Way?

***Jesus is the Truth** - Read: **John 8:31-32; John 1:14; Ephesians 4:21**

Discussion Questions:

- How does Jesus define truth in these passages?
- In what ways does the truth of Christ bring **freedom**?
- What is the difference between the truth of Jesus and the "relative truth" the world promotes?

***Jesus is the Life** - Read: **John 10:10; John 11:25; 1 John 5:11-12**

Discussion Questions:

- What does it mean to have "abundant life" in Christ?
- How does knowing Jesus is the resurrection and the life change our perspective on death?
- In what areas of your life do you feel you need more of Christ's life?

***Personal Application** - Reflection Questions:

- Am I walking daily with Jesus as my Way?
- Am I allowing His Truth to transform my thoughts, words, and actions?
- Am I enjoying the fullness of life that only Christ can give, or am I settling for less?
